

Health, safety remain IACMI's top priority for Fall 2021 Members Meeting

Everyone's health and safety remain our top priority. Our team is working to make sure your participation in the in-person Members Meeting is safe so you can focus on networking safely and getting down to business.

Masks Requested: To promote a safe meeting environment, IACMI is requesting masks be worn. This will reduce your risks and protect others around you. If you choose to participate in the IACMI Scale-up Research Facility (SURF) tours, at this time Michigan State University (MSU) is requiring masks be worn by all visitors and guests while inside the facility. Masks will be required during shuttle services to the evening reception at The Henry Ford Museum and to SURF tours.

Physical Distancing/Color-Coded System: We will practice "physical distancing" in our meeting rooms and in our main sessions, spacing tables and chairs in a way to ensure safe distancing. Additional signs will be posted throughout the venue reminding attendees to maintain safe distancing, as necessary.

We will also be implementing a color-coded system at the registration desk to help attendees signal their social distancing comfort levels to others. Upon check-in, you can choose between either a red dot, yellow dot, or green dot sticker to put on your badge. Each colored sticker represents a different level of comfort:

- Red Dot = No contact. Six feet apart, no exceptions
- Yellow Dot = Elbow-to-elbow only. Still being cautious
- Green Dot = High-fives & handshakes. Frequent hand washing

We want you to feel comfortable with your social interactions at our event!

Hand Sanitizer Stations: Hand sanitizer stations will be available in high traffic areas, including hotel meeting spaces, the Front Desk, and guest elevators. IACMI and hotel staff will be wiping down frequently touched surfaces, including registration iPads upon check-in to our members meeting.

Food & Beverage: The hotel and museum are taking extra steps and have added layers of caution to ensure protocols are in place for food and beverage service for minimal handling.

The Henry Hotel will also be practicing the following additional measures:

- **Staff Safety Protocols:**
 - Ambassadors will follow CDC guidelines with frequent hand washing, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and COVID-19 training.
- **High Touch Objects:**
 - Hotel staff have increased the frequency of cleaning, disinfecting, and sanitizing all high-touch surfaces and areas such as door handles and elevator buttons.
- **Guest Room Care:**
 - Hotel staff use EPA-recommended, CDC-approved cleaning and disinfecting products that are effective against COVID-19 and a broad spectrum of other viruses.
